Dear Parishioners,



In the pages that follow is a summary of parish income and expenses for the fiscal year that concluded in June. Our total ordinary income increased by \$169k over the prior fiscal year. About \$40k of the increase was from faith formation fees. This was due mostly to the fact that we started registration for the 2023-24 faith formation year in May of this year. The balance of the increase was due to your generous donations. There continues to be a trend towards more online giving, which is something we encourage. During COVID, we stopped passing the collection basket around, instead placing collection boxes at church entrances for those who wish to give by check or cash. Since we have received positive feedback from our community, we have decided to continue this practice.

Our expenses increased by \$114k, \$36k of which was due to higher costs for employee health insurance. While we have many excellent volunteers, employing trained professionals is necessary to provide high quality services to our 2,800 parish families. We also invested significant funds to improve our office computers and migrate to the cloud, something that was long overdue. As we do every year, our parish made significant donations to the Annual Catholic Appeal, the Oaxaca Education Fund, St. Mary's School, St. Rita's School, and other charities.

We are excited to share that construction of the Discipleship Center is almost complete. In addition to the money contributed as part of the Built on Rock Capital Campaign, we estimate that we will need to borrow \$1.25 million to pay for the project, only a portion of the amount previously estimated for which we have already received approval. Your continued contributions to the capital campaign will be used to retire this debt.

I leave you with a note from one of the original fundraisers for the Kingdom of God, St. Paul: "Consider this: whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows bountifully will also reap bountifully... for God loves a cheerful giver. Moreover, God is able to make every grace abundant for you, so that in all things, always having all you need, you may have an abundance for every good work." (2 Cor. 9:6-8)

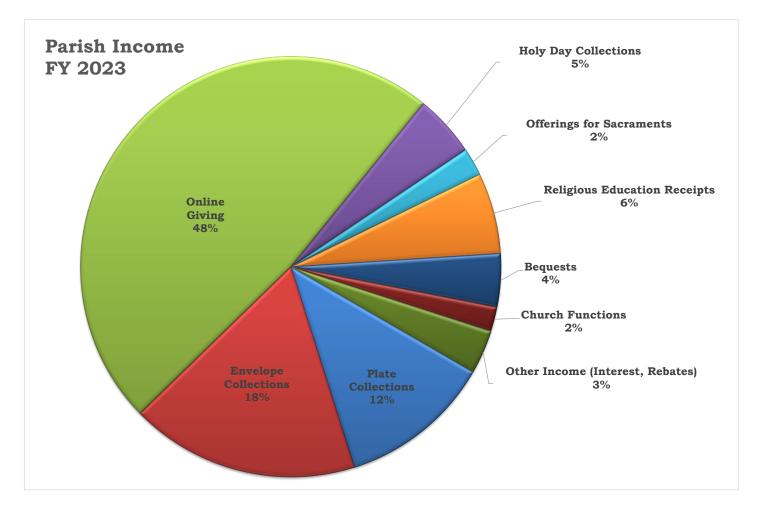

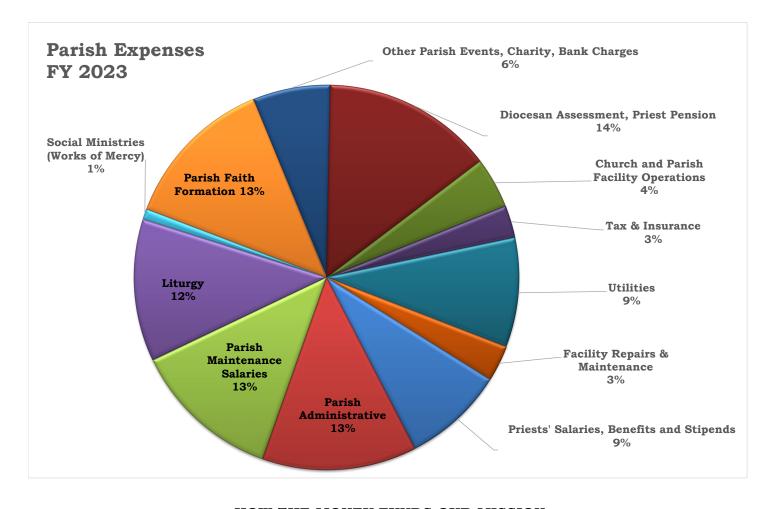
