

# PARISH FINANCIAL REPORT



September 16, 2018

Dear Parishioners,

This report shows another year of faithful stewardship by our parish. Thanks to your generosity and the prudent management of expenses by parish staff, OLMC's operating surplus was \$270,254 for fiscal year 2017-18. Building fund donations were \$28,447 less than the previous year. We are expected to pay off our debt sometime in 2019. After that, building fund donations will be saved for eventual purchase of our solar energy system (now being leased) and for future construction of a new hall, offices, and meeting spaces. Feel free to contact our business manager or Finance Council members to answer any questions about this report.

In all my years as a priest, this is the best team of staff and volunteers with which I have worked. Your contributions have not only made this possible, but have enabled the parish to make significant donations to outside charities such as Children of the Immaculate Heart (which helps victims of sex trafficking) and St. Mary's School.

I want to share with you important changes in legal structures within the Diocese of San Diego. The legal structure of the parish is a corporation sole in which I am the sole executive officer. The financial assets of this entity are funds in our savings account. The parish land and buildings are held in trust by the Diocese of San Diego.

Plans are in the works to create a separate supporting corporation which would own the parish land and buildings. This entity will be governed by a board of directors which includes myself, the OLMC Finance Council Chair, Alex Koenig, another priest, and two lay employees of the Parish Services Corporation. The Parish Services Corporation is a new entity responsible for providing financial, legal, and human resource support to parishes in exchange for about 2.5% of Sunday collections. I was elected by priests to the board of this corporation which employs professionals who previously worked for the Diocese and will hire additional professionals to carry out its mandate.

These changes mean that the parish has greater legal independence from the Diocese. Many people think that parishes are micromanaged by the Bishop, but that is not true. Apart from appointing the priests to serve in a parish, the Bishop does not make many decisions for the parishes. The Catholic Church teaching that local governance is best (principle of subsidiarity) is embodied in canon law and now will be more fully embodied in civil law.

These changes also mean that lay Catholics will have greater legal authority in running the local Church. As the sex abuse scandals have shown us, lay involvement is needed to ensure greater accountability on the part of bishops and priests. I hope this is a trend that will continue.

I am on sabbatical as you read this. Be assured that wherever I am and whatever I am doing, you are in my heart. I am grateful for all the ways you live your faith and contribute the vibrancy of OLMC. May God continue to bless us with an abundance of gifts, and may we continue to be good stewards of those gifts.






